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CPPE Newly Qualified Pharmacist Programme 2023-24

The Centre for Pharmacy Postgraduate Education (CPPE) and NHS England (NHSE) <u>Newly</u> <u>Qualified Pharmacist Programme</u> is now open for registration. Please see the information below from CPPE and the <u>website</u> for further information about the training offer provided and eligibility.

Key dates – Two Cohorts for 2023-24

Cohort 5: Applications are open and will close on 30 October 2023. The programme will begin on 6 November 2023

Cohort 6: Applications will open on 8th January 2024 and close on 18th March 2024 with a start date of 25th March 2024.

Note: NHS England WT&E provides separate funding for pharmacists working for Boots or in hospital pharmacy. These pharmacists are **not** eligible to apply for the CPPE programme. The regional launch for Newly Qualified Pharmacist Pathway for hospital pharmacists will be mid-Sept 2023 and will be shared to organisation education leads.
