- **Senior Healthcare Support Worker (SHCSW) – Diagnostic Imaging Support Option:**

The North East London General Practice Nurse Vocational Training Scheme 2024 – 2025

The Primary Care Nursing Workforce Team and the North East London (NEL) GPN Lead Nurses are planning for the next cohort of the General Practice Nurse Vocational Training Scheme (GPN VTS) for Registered Nurses (RNs) new to General Practice.

The scheme aims to recruit and train nurses across NEL to work in general practice, addressing the nationwide struggle to recruit experienced practice nurses. A training grant of £20,000 will be available to support the salaries and efforts of developing the next cohort of GPNs.
