- A team that has undertaken 150 COPD QOF reviews in 3 days, and provided a “Winter MOT” for this group, including any missing vaccinations
- A team whose group clinic work with a group of children with complex asthma led to prevention of hospitalisation over the winter months
- A team who responded to demand for GP appointments from families with young children about common childhood illness and Strep A in 2022 with a group care model that meant they felt confident to cope without a visit to the GP
