PCPEP for non-PCN ARRS pharmacy professionals funded places

! New Training Opportunity for Pharmacists and Pharmacy Technicians!

NHS England has partnered with the Centre for Pharmacy Postgraduate Education (CPPE) to offer compulsory training for pharmacists and pharmacy technicians. This initiative is part of the Additional Role Reimbursement Scheme (ARRS) and focuses on the Primary Care Pharmacy Education Pathway.

Who is Eligible: Pharmacists and pharmacy technicians seeking to enhance their skills in patient-facing medicines optimisation and related services within general practice and care home settings are eligible. To qualify, applicants must:

- Currently work in a patient-facing primary care role for a minimum of approximately 0.5 wte (2.5 18.75 hours per week) in a GP practice or care home setting.
- Have employer support, including release for 28 days of protected learning time, provision of clinical supervision, and covering travel expenses.
- Commit to attending face-to-face events, including residential study days, and dedicating up to 30 days of personal study time over the training period.

Duration and Content: The training spans 18 months for pharmacists and 15 months for pharmacy technicians, offering a comprehensive workplace-based curriculum. Details are available on the CPPE website.

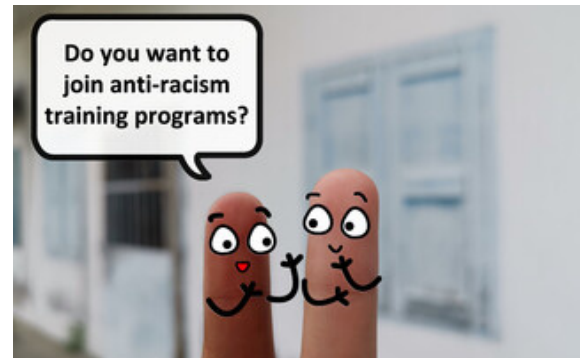
